Check camera access is enabled

Safari on iOS

1. Open the Settings app.
2. Tap on Safari.
3. Scroll down to Camera and tap it.
4. Confirm that **Ask** or **Allow** is checked.

Chrome on iOS

1. Open the Settings app.
2. Tap on Chrome.
3. Tap to turn camera on or off (green is on).

Edge on iOS

1. Open the Settings app.
2. Tap on Edge.
3. Tap to turn camera on or off (green is on).

Opera on iOS

1. Open the Settings app.
2. Tap on Opera.
3. Tap to turn camera on or off (green is on).

Change a site's camera permissions on Chrome on Android

METHOD 1

1. Open the Settings app.
2. Tap Apps & Notifications, then Tap **Advanced**.
3. Scroll down to Permission Manager. Tap Permission Manager.
4. Tap Camera. If Chrome is not listed under **Allowed all the time** or **Allowed only while in use**, scroll to **Denied**.
5. Tap Chrome. Then, tap either **Allow**, or **Ask**.

METHOD 2

1. On your Android device, open the Chrome app.
2. To the right of the address bar, tap the 3 dot icon > Settings.
3. Scroll down to Site Settings. Tap **Site Settings**.
4. Tap Microphone or Camera.
5. Tap to turn the microphone or camera on or off.

To allow or block sites from accessing your camera in **Opera on Android**

METHOD 1

1. Open the Settings app.
2. Tap Apps & Notifications, then Tap **Advanced**.
3. Scroll down to Permission Manager. Tap **Permission Manager**.
4. Tap Camera. If Opera is not listed under **Allowed all the time** or **Allowed only while in use**, scroll down to **Denied**.
5. Tap Opera. Tap either **Allow**, or **Ask**.

METHOD 2

1. Open your Android settings by tapping the Settings app on your device.
2. Tap Apps & notifications (this might **have** a different label on your version of Android).
3. Tap Opera.
4. Tap Permissions.
5. Tap Camera.
6. Tap Allow.

Grant camera access to **Firefox for Android**

METHOD 1

1. Open the Settings app.
2. Tap Apps & Notifications, then Tap **Advanced**.
3. Scroll down to Permission Manager. Tap **Permission Manager**.
4. Tap Camera. If Firefox is not listed under **Allowed all the time** or **Allowed only while in use**, scroll down to **Denied**.
5. Tap Firefox. Then, tap either **Allow**, or **Ask**.

METHOD 2

1. Open your Android settings by tapping the Settings app on your device.
2. Tap Apps & notifications (this might have a different label on your version of Android).
3. Tap Firefox.
4. Tap Permissions.
5. Tap Camera.
6. Tap Allow.

To control access to camera and microphone on **Microsoft Edge**

METHOD 1

1. Open the Settings app.
2. Tap Apps & Notifications, then Tap **Advanced**.
3. Scroll down to Permission Manager. Tap **Permission Manager**.
4. Tap Camera. If Edge under **Allowed all the time** or **Allowed only while in use**, scroll down to **Denied**.
5. Tap Edge. Then, tap either **Allow**, or **Ask**.

METHOD 2

1. Open your Android settings by tapping the Settings app on your device.
2. Tap Apps & notifications (this might have a different label on your version of Android).
3. Tap Firefox.
4. Tap Permissions.
5. Tap Camera.
6. Tap Allow.
